31 Best Time to Visit

- Temple of the Tooth, lakeside walks, and Kandyan dance traditions.

Nuwara Eliya & Ella – Tea Country

Galle & the South – Forts & Beaches

- Galle Fort's cobblestone charm; beach escapes in Unawatuna, Mirissa, and Tangalle.

Yala & Udawalawe – Wildlife Safaris

- Spot leopards, elephants, and rich birdlife in national parks.

Trincomalee & Arugam Bay – The East

- Calm coves, snorkeling, and world-class surf breaks (seasonal).

Travel Tips

- Currency: Sri Lankan Rupee (LKR).

- Etiquette: Shoulders/knees covered at temples; remove shoes and hats.
